Information for Authors

- 1. Articles must have a high degree of scholarship. They will be screened by the editorial board and undergo a double-blind review.
- 2. Submissions may be written in English or Filipino. All articles written in either language must be accompanied by an abstract of not more than 300 words and five keywords written in English.
- 3. Reviews of books, exhibits, websites, films, fora, and other relevant events are also accepted.
- 4. The article length is 5,000 to 12,000 words, and review length about 1,500 words.
- 5. Send your submission as an email attachment to The Editor-in-Chief (see email address below). The following file types are accepted: rtf, doc, docx.
- 6. References must be listed at the end of the article and follow MLA style (8th edition, 2016). Non-English sources must be accompanied by English translations.
- 7. Photos accompanying articles should have a resolution of at least 300 dpi.
- 8. It is the author's responsibility to secure permission for the use of copyrighted materials.
- 9. Submissions should be accompanied by a short biographical note (around five lines), which should include the author's present position and institutional affiliation, as well as email address. Please list down funding sources, if any, in connection with the research and/or writing of your paper (write none if there are no funding sources).
