The Integrated Graduate Program (IGP) provides a collaborative and interdisciplinary learning environment through the offering of flexible curricula. These allow entry points for all fields of expertise and dynamic courses that tackle emergent issues to undertake cutting-edge research in the Designed and Built Environments.

The IGP has five (5) component degree programs:











GDipLS

Graduate Diploma in Landscape Studies

A one-year program for non-B Landscape Architecture degree holders to proceed to the Master of Tropical Landscape Architecture and, thereafter, take the LA licensure exam.



MAAS

Master of Arts in Architecture Studies

A non-thesis two-year program for non-BS Architecture degree holders, who are interested to immerse in spatial theories, concepts, and strategies.



MArch

Master of Architecture

An updated two-year program significantly reconfigured to incorporate new design and policy-making practice, innovative design conceptualization processes, and emergent industry needs.



MTLA

Master of Tropical Landscape Architecture

A revitalized two-year program bringing in the latest and emergent design concepts and approaches for outdoor environments in urban and rural settings.



PHDDBE

Doctor of Philosophy in the Designed and Built Environment

A four-year program for Architecture/Landscape Architecture-related fields, Interior Design, Urban Planning, Civil Engineering (Track A); and for all other fields (Track B).

Students may select from among the research themes, which are administered by Studio Laboratories. **Research themes** are general directions towards which specific thesis or dissertation topics may be aligned.
