Information for Authors

Content and Format

The *Philippine Social Sciences Review* (PSSR) is the official and peer-reviewed journal of the College of Social Sciences and Philosophy (CSSP), University of the Philippines, Diliman. It aims to promote critical exchanges of research/theory-based ideas between scholars in and outside the Philippines. It accepts articles, reports, notes, and book reviews on the social sciences and on issues related to the social sciences broadly defined and philosophy in the Philippine context from scholars all over the world.

Articles may be written in English or Filipino and must not have been published in any form nor are under consideration for publication elsewhere. Full-length articles must be about 6,000-8,000 words, with an abstract in English of not more than 200 words. Reports and notes should be about 4,000-5,000 words. Book reviews on recently released books must be between 1,000 to 1,500 words.

Submissions must be formatted following the style rules set by the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (APA style, 6th edition). Endnotes should be kept to a minimum. A full style sheet is available upon request.

Book Reviews

Reviews of recent books published in the past three years on Philippine history, society, culture, politics, thought, heritage, and arts are accepted.

The review should not exceed 1,500 words in .doc format and should be e-mailed to the Editor. It must include a brief summary of the contents of the material, followed by a critical appraisal of its substance and execution. It should reflect first the nature of the material and the reviewer's ideas next. It must include the complete citation of the material and the name and institutional affiliation of the reviewer at the end of the review. It is subject to editorial screening.

The review must include the complete citation of the material and the name and institutional affiliation of the reviewer at the end of the article. Interested reviewers are encouraged to contact the Editor to signify intent and discuss book title options.
